We believe in women's empowerment, economic justice, economic safety and equity. We pledge to action against Economic Abuse and other forms of gender-based violence.

- We understand that Economic Abuse is a common but often overlooked and understudied form of domestic violence that has detrimental impacts on a survivor's access to social support services, mental and physical well-being, housing insecurity, generational trauma and additional forms of marginalization. Economic Abuse affects generations of people in Canada regardless of socio-economic status, race, age or other identity factors.
- We believe that Economic Abuse victim-survivors have the right to live without any form of violence and be supported on their journey to regain control over their lives.
- We call on all levels of government, private, leaders, and public stakeholders to work together to take action in addressing and preventing and responding Economic Abuse.
- We demand accountability from leaders to deliver on their duty to bring justice to survivors and victims of Economic Abuse.
- We commit to raising awareness about Economic Abuse within our work and to inform ourselves on how to recognize, identify, respond to, and prevent Economic Abuse from escalating or continuing.
- We stand in solidarity with CCFWE to fight Economic Abuse and dedicate ourselves to finding lasting solutions for victim-survivors economic safety and security .
